

# *Summer Jazz Workshop, June 17 - 21, 2012*

The University of Nebraska–Lincoln School of Music and the Jazz Studies Area at UNL is proud to announce the creation of the **Summer Jazz Workshop**. Unlike typical jazz band camps, the focus of the UNL Jazz Workshop is on the exploration and the creation of music through improvisation in the small group setting. By removing the barriers faced by many young players, they can learn to discover their own unique voice and creative outlet. This camp is open to any instrumental student entering 9th grade through the end of the 12th grade. There is no set instrumentation and all students are encouraged to apply. This workshop is for you if you are interested in improvising and have a desire to move to the next level.

**The Jazz Workshop registration form AND full payment must be submitted by 5:00 PM on June 1, 2012. The registration form is located at <https://unlmusic.slideroom.com/> . Fees are payable via credit or debit card.**

## *Registration Form Instructions*

*The Jazz Workshop registration form uses Flash software. You cannot access the form from an iPhone or an iPad. You can access the form from any computer (Mac, PC or Android device) that has Flash installed. See [adobe.com/](http://adobe.com/) for the free download (player version), if necessary. You can start the form on one computer and finish it on another as long as you remember your username and password.*

*The form is quite easy to use so feel free to log on and start an registration. You can change your answers; stop and come back later; add your credit card information at another time; until you click the submit button. Incomplete registrations will be removed after the June 1 deadline.*

1. Go to the web page located at <https://unlmusic.slideroom.com/>
2. Set up an account using the camper's (STUDENT'S) e-mail address and a password of your choice. Be sure to click the **SIGNUP** button on your first entry. You can leave and return to the registration form repeatedly until you have completed all questions and have included your credit or debit card information. Click the **LOG IN** button on return visits to the registration site.
3. After you log in you will see a **SlideRoom Account Registration** screen. This is where the camper (STUDENT) provides us with contact information. PLEASE use the student's name and not the parent's name or the band director's name (we'll ask for that information on a subsequent screen). This is the ONLY screen where the camper can give us with their name and contact information.

4. Click the **Start A New Submission** button. The **Available Programs** screen will appear. Click on **Jazz Workshop** under **Categories** on the left side of the screen. Two choices will appear: **Jazz Workshop Resident Camper** and **Jazz Workshop Day Camper**. Click on the **Apply Now** button to the right of the appropriate listing for your workshop package choice. A folder icon will appear on this screen under **Pending Submissions** if you exit the registration form and return at a later time. Click on that icon to resume your registration when you return.
5. Answer all of the questions on each of the screens. Click on the **Next Step** button to take you to each successive screen. Note that the **Next Step** button will remain inactive (grayed out) until you have answered all of the mandatory questions on each screen. You may have to scroll down to see all of the questions depending on the size of your monitor or screen. Also note that there may be two scroll bars on the right of your screen. That is a function of Flash software over which we have no control.
6. The final step is payment of the appropriate workshop registration fees (\$330 for resident campers or \$305 for day campers with meals). **Credit card information is required.** Click the **Payment Confirmation** button and then click the **Submit** button. Note that you cannot return to the form once you click the submit button.
